As many of you are aware, the Cities of Fargo, Moorhead, and West Fargo are undergoing preparations and are projecting a river crest of 38 feet on or about March 20, 2010.

In comparison, the river reached 40.8 feet in 2009. Due to the planning and preparation of the Cities of Fargo, Moorhead, West Fargo and the GOLDMARK team we did not experience any flooding or related problems in your current GOLDMARK managed property.

We are making appropriate preparations to protect our buildings. However, it is also appropriate that you make personal plans for your safety and belongings as situations can change quickly.
